CRYSTAL COVE ALLIANCE'S 9TH ANNUAL BEACH GALA RAISES \$200,000

On Sept. 24, 425 guests hit the bluffs of Crystal Cove for CCA's annual fundraising gala themed "Surf, Sand and the Silver Screen" after the area's rich movie-making history. The evening began with a walk down the red carpet greeted by movie characters (played by Chapman University theatrical group CAST), followed by cocktails and hors d'oeuvres above the beach. Notable attendees included Honorary Chairs Madeline and James Irvine Swinden, Director of California State Parks Ruth Coleman, The Beachcomber Café founder Doug Cavanaugh and Laguna Beach Mayor Toni Iseman.
